Organized since 2004, the scientific event was intended to be periodic (annual) and itinerant in Romanian university centers or cities with scientific and economic potential. In the field of electromagnetic compatibility it is a response to the current imperatives of society aimed at new developments in scientific research.

Over time, the EMC Workshop's topic was extended to the medical field, including other two scientific events organized in 2007 and 2008 in this field.

Starting from 2010, was decided to be organized every two years.
